<u>Eligibility</u>: Applicants must have a minimum of 55% marks (UR Category) and 50% marks (reserved category) in the Post Graduate/ Acharya level. Candidates in service may apply through proper channel. The eligibility of the candidate will be as per UGC rules, but the enrolled/registered Ph. D./ Vidyavaridhi candidates may not get the facilities of UGC-JRF or Nonnet Fellowship / Scholarship at present.

Students who have cleared UGC-NET/ SET/SLET or equivalent examinations or were awarded M. Phil./ Vishistacharya from any recognized university are not required to appear in the written examination (RET) but they have to appear in the interview.
