The erstwhile Sanskrit College in Kolkata was established on 01/01/1824 and it started functioning on and from 25th of February, 1824 as the Second Higher Learning Institution under British Rule in India. Pandit Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar became the First Indian Principal of this college in 1851. Many other luminaries studied & taught in this important institution, contributing significantly in Bengal's literary and cultural milieu.

The erstwhile Sanskrit College was turned into the current Sanskrit College and University vide The Sanskrit College and University Act XXXIII of 2015 of Government of West Bengal. This unitary university is fast becoming a hub of contemporary liberal arts education, with a strong stress on research and learning.
