

REPORT ON THE HAR GHAR TIRANGA CAMPAIGN PROGRAMME

The Sanskrit College and University, Kolkata, organised a three-day programme under the “**Har Ghar Tiranga**” Campaign from **13th to 15th August 2026** at the College Street Campus of the University, in accordance with the directives issued by the Government of West Bengal. The programme witnessed the active participation of the University authorities, teachers, officers, non-teaching employees, including contractual, casual and outsourced personnel, and students. The campaign aimed to foster patriotism, national unity and respect for the National Flag among all members of the University community.

13th August 2026: Poster Competition

On **13th August 2026**, a **Poster Competition** on the theme “**Har Ghar Tiranga**” was organised for the students of the University. The competition provided an opportunity for the students to express their patriotic भावना and creative ideas through art. The participants enthusiastically presented posters reflecting the significance of the National Flag, the spirit of independence and the ideals of unity and integrity.

The event received an encouraging response from the students and marked the beginning of the University's three-day observance of the Har Ghar Tiranga Campaign.

14th August 2026: Seminar and Exhibition

On **14th August 2026**, a seminar entitled “**বঙ্গভঙ্গ : প্রেক্ষাপট, অভিঘাত ও পরিণাম**” was organised at the **Vidyasagar Hall** of the University on the subject of the Partition of Bengal and its historical context, impact and consequences.

The seminar was graced by the presence of **Prof. Dr. Ayan Bhattacharya, the Honourable Vice-Chancellor, Dr. Lokanath Chakrabarti, Registrar (Acting), Shri Debasish Chowdhury, Deputy Registrar, Mr. Subrata Bhowmik, Chief Guest, and Dr. Tanmay Kumar Bhattacharya**. On the same day, an **exhibition on the theme of India's Independence Day** was inaugurated by the Honourable Vice-Chancellor of the University. 15th August 2026: Flag Hoisting, Tiranga Rally and Prize Distribution

On **15th August 2026**, the University observed **Independence Day** as part of the Har Ghar Tiranga Campaign at the College Street Campus.

The **National Flag** was hoisted by **Prof. Dr. Ayan Bhattacharya, the Honourable Vice-Chancellor of The Sanskrit College and University (SCU)**, in the presence of **Dr. Lokanath Chakrabarti, Registrar (Acting)**, faculty members, non-teaching staff and students of the University. The flag-hoisting ceremony was solemnly accompanied by the rendition of “**Vande Mataram**” and the National Anthem, “**Jana Gana Mana.**”
