D/ Vidyāvāridhi** programmes in the Departments of Sanskrit, Bengali, English, Ancient Indian and World History, and Linguistics/ Advaita Vedanta and Sahitya (under Traditional Oriental Learning) from the eligible Post Graduate / Acharya students of the respective subjects (or allied subjects/ disciplines subject to endorsement by Ph. D. committee).

Eligibility: Applicants must have a minimum of **55%** marks (General Category) and **50%** marks (reserved category) in the Post Graduate/ Acharya level. Candidates in service may apply through the proper channel. The eligibility of the candidate will be as per UGC rules, but the enrolled/registered Ph. D./ Vidyavaridhi candidates may not get the facilities of UGC-JRF or Non net Fellowship / Scholarship at present.

The students who have cleared **UGC-NET/ SET/SLET** or equivalent examinations or were awarded **M. Phil./ Vishistacharya** from any recognized university are not required to appear in the written examination (RET) but they have to appear in the interview.

All other eligible candidates will have to appear in a written examination (**RET**) of two hours duration. The list of the selected candidates for interview will be displayed on the Notice Board and shared on the university webpage. The final selection for joining this programme will be made on the basis of the interview.

The last date for receiving online applications is 30th December 2022

The last date for receiving hard copies of the application form is 11th January 2023
