Fourth Year: Semester-VII

In this Fourth-Year students who secure 75% and above in the first six (6) semesters and wish to undertake research at the Undergraduate level can choose a research stream. All others will have to complete the Four-Year UG Honours Degree Programme. However, the Core Courses for both the groups will remain same in the Seventh Semester. In the Eighth Semester students having Honours with Research shall do a research project / dissertation of 12 credits in the major discipline and students of four-year UG Honours degree shall have three Core Courses of 4 credits each instead of the dissertation. One Core Course on Seminar Presentation will be common for both in the Eighth Semester.

Honours subjects. Students of any other Honours subjects can only opt the Minor Course (PALI/MI/301) offered by this Department.
